

CALLING ALL PARENTS AND CHILD CARERS TO CHILD SAFETY WORKSHOPS**12 October 2015**

Over 90% of child injuries are preventable - a scary statistic which is one of the motivating factors behind the partnership between Childsafe and Woolworths. Together, they aim to raise awareness around child safety and assist parents and child carers in developing crucial life saving techniques and safety skills through Child Safety courses.

The two day Child Safety course focuses on practical ways to prevent different accidents in and around the home such as poisoning, drowning, choking, burns, road accidents and general accidents. It also includes a five hour infant and child emergency care course (First Aid). The course is tailor-made for parents, nannies, domestic workers and anyone who is looking after a young child or baby at home.

The next two day course is scheduled for 24 and 31 October 2015 and will be held at the Woolworths Childsafe Research & Educational Centre at the Red Cross War Memorial Children's Hospital. The two day course costs R150 per person which includes a training course manual, certificate and catering on both days.
